

Woodlands, Queensland



Time Frame

- 2005 – 2011 approx.

Location

- Suburb of Waterford 30km south of Brisbane CBD, 38km to Gold Coast

Size / Population

- 137.3 hectares
- Approx 1,360 dwellings
- 3,500 people on completion

Education

- The renowned Canterbury College is adjacent to Woodlands providing private education from Prep to Grade 12. There are a number of state and private schools as well as childcare facilities within a 10 min drive from Woodlands
- Griffith University and Logan TAFE provide tertiary education and are less than 15min drive from Woodlands.

Shopping

- Convenience shopping is located within a five min drive at Bethania, Edens Landing, Beenleigh and Waterford West. Logan Hyperdome is a major shopping centre within 15 min drive from Woodlands.

Block sizes

- Range between 240m² - 6000m² with an average traditional block of 640m²

Display Village

- There are six homes on display at the Delfin Living Options Display Village

Adventure Links

- A community activity network providing residents the opportunity to enjoy a range of activities in a variety of natural surrounds
- Seven km of cycle and pedestrian paths connect all areas of open space including the parks outdoor gym, children's play equipments, BBQ & Picnic facilities, multi-purpose courts and environmental corridors
- Residents will have access to an all-year round recreational, social, educational and cultural activity program, which will also form part of the Adventure Links

Transport

- Easy access to Pacific Highway (M1) and Logan Motorway with Bus & Rail within 2.5km

Open Space

- More than 30 hectares of open space (equivalent to 25 football fields) including a 17-hectare environmental corridor, seven parks and multi-purpose courts

School Programs

- Work experience opportunities for local students in areas of construction, furniture and sign building
