- Greensborough Centre opened in 1978
- Purchased by Lend Lease in 1987
- Refurbished 1989/90
- Sold to MLC Life/APPF Retail in 1989 and renamed Valley Central
- Redeveloped by Lend Lease between 1993 – 1995 and renamed Greensborough Plaza
- MLC Life stake sold to SAS Trustee Corporation in 2000
- Australian Prime Property Fund acquired 100% of the centre in 2005
